2017 Summer STEM Camp FAQs

WHO MAY ATTEND?

Elementary students currently enrolled in a K4 – 8th grade program. STEM CAMPS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

WHEN WILL THE STEM CAMPS TAKE PLACE?

There will be three – 1 week camps held during the month of June from 7:30am – 3:30pm.

Week A: June 5-9, 2017 ~ STEM-tastic Week

Week B: June 12-16, 2017 ~ Imaginarium Week

Week C: June 19-23, 2017 ~ Mad Scientist Week

WHAT TYPES OF CAMPS WILL BE OFFERED?

Each week will have a different theme with classes that coordinate to each theme (please see camp descriptions).

WHAT WILL THE MAXIMUM ENROLLMENT FOR EACH CAMP?

The number of students in each camp will vary depending on the topic. Each Camp will enroll a maximum of 20.

WHAT IS THE COST?

- ~ One Week Camp: \$130/per week
- ~ Non-Refundable Registration Fee: \$20.00 (one-time fee)
- ~ ***Some camps have a Field Trip fee or a Kit Fee**
- ~ LFS STEM Camp Shirt: \$12.00 (optional- must be registered by May15)- needed for Field Trip Camps

WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT ARE ACCEPTED?

Cash, checks and credit cards will be accepted. Please make checks payable to Little Flower Catholic School.

WHAT RULES AND EXPECTATIONS APPLY?

The rules and expectations that apply during the regular school year apply during summer camps as well. It is expected that all students will behave in a manner that is respectful to other students. Repeated misbehavior will be grounds for dismissal from camp program without a refund.

HOW CAN I REGISTER MY CHILD FOR CAMP?

Registration packets will be sent home in your child's folder. CAMP Registration forms can be found on our website at www.littleflowercatholicsschool.org. Complete the registration forms and return with registration fee and payment as soon as possible. Spots will be filled on a first come basis.

WILL LUNCH BE PROVIDED TO MY CHILD?

Lunch is not included in the camp cost and will not be provided. Students must bring their lunch daily.

HOW WILL I BE NOTIFIED THAT MY CHILD HAS BEEN ACCEPTED INTO A CAMP?

A confirmation letter will be either emailed or sent through the mail. Please verify your email address on the registration form

WHAT IF A CAMP DOES NOT HAVE THE MINIMUM OF 12 CAMPERS ENROLLED?

If a camp does not meet the minimum of 12 campers, the camp will be cancelled and the parent will be contacted to ask if another camp would be considered.

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2017 Summer STEM Camp Rules

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Little Flower School rules will apply. It is expected that all students will behave in a manner that is respectful to other students. In addition, a closed campus will be observed during all camps.

Registration: Registration packets will be sent home with students. Space will be limited for each camp and registration forms will be accepted on a first come basis. The cost for each camp is \$130.00 per week, with a \$20.00 registration fee and an optional t-shirt fee of \$12.00. *(There is an additional fee for Solar Robotics and those camps that include a Field Trip.)* Payment must be submitted with your registration in order to secure a spot.

Attendance: Parents/Guardians are urged to encourage their student to attend camp every day. If a student misses more than one day, and is enrolled for a second camp, we reserve the right to cancel the registration for the second camp and offer the spot to a student on the waiting list. In addition, fees will not be refunded for missed days.

Drop-off/Pick-up Information: Students are to be dropped off and picked up at the front foyer of Little Flower School. Students may not be dropped off before 7:30 am and must be picked up by 3:30pm. There will be a charge of \$5.00 per 10 minutes after 3:30 pm for late pick up.

Dress Code: School uniforms are not required during summer camps. Students may wear appropriate clothing and/or camp shirt (preferred) with shorts, however, the following rules apply: **No** tank tops, midriiffs, halter tops, cut offs, or flip flops will be allowed. Shorts, skorts, skirts/dresses, must be knee length. Clothing with objectionable language and/or artwork will not be allowed. Students found in violation of the dress code will be sent home.

Discipline: Students are expected to adhere to the Little Flower School Code of Conduct. Misbehavior may result in withdrawal from camp without a refund.
